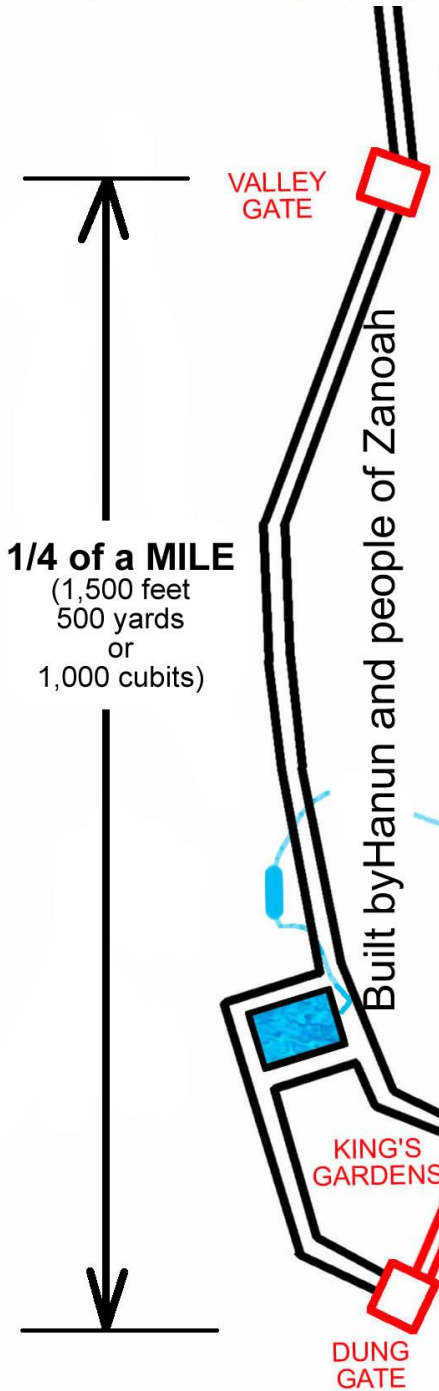

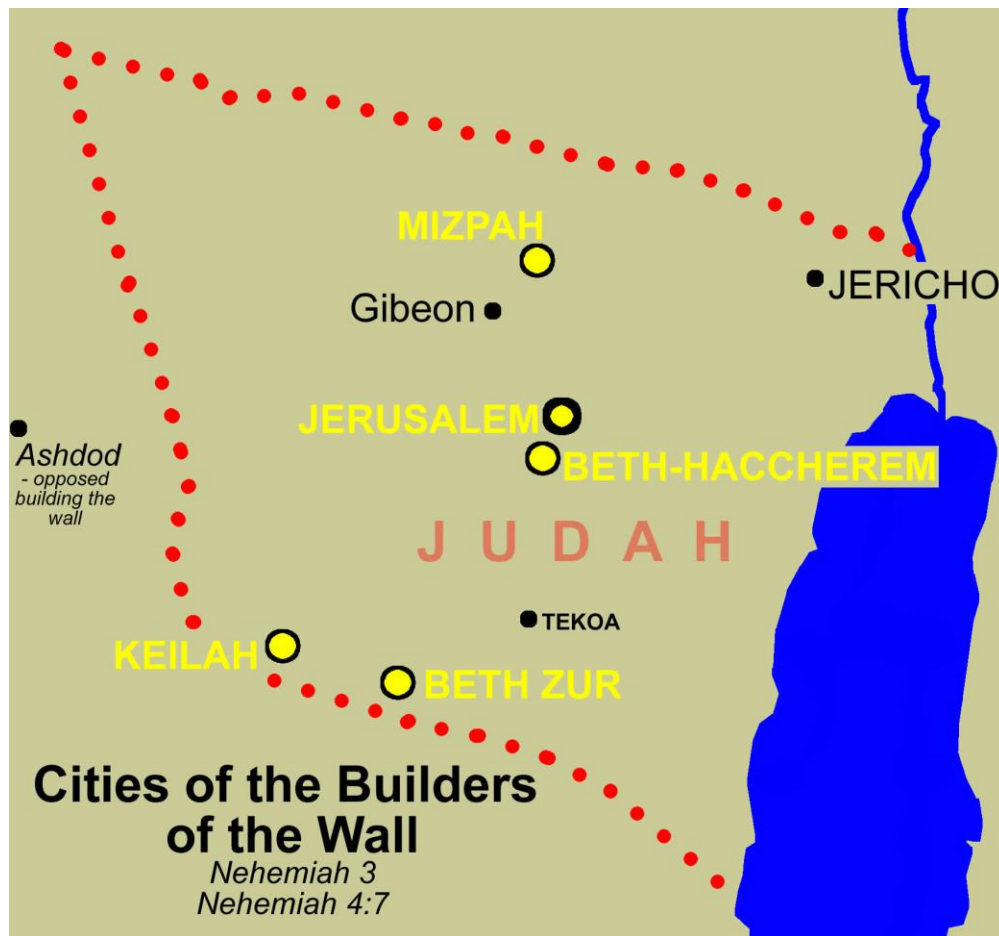

The three smaller districts (Beth-haccherem, Mizpah, Beth-zur) each have one leader.

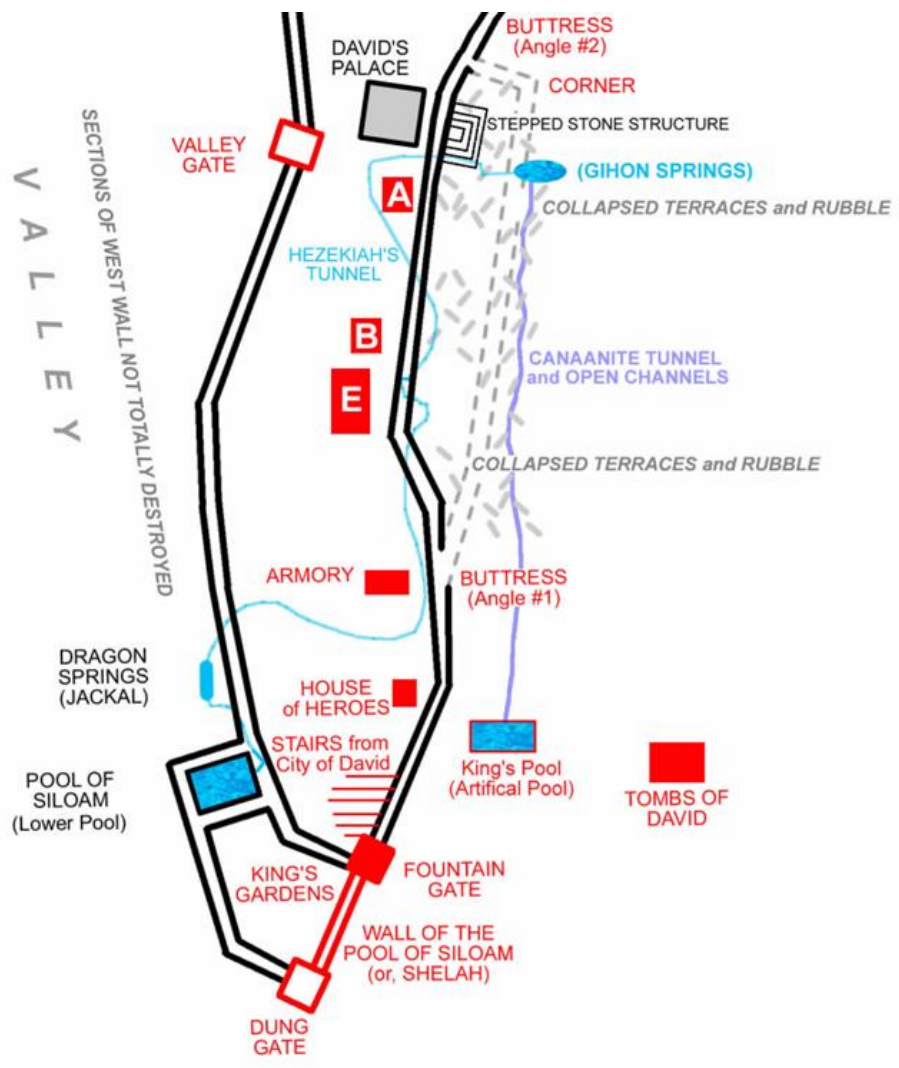
