
Thrones, Dominions, Rulers and Authorities – "Angelology"


1:16 – "For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things were created through him and for him."



- 1. Oti "because", "for" the proof of his supremacy "FOR" or "BECAUSE" ("oti").
- 2. *en auto* is "in him" or "by him" meaning he is the sphere.
- 3. Panta is "all things"
 - a. Used 2x in this verse
 - b. "all things" was used in Paul's day as the word "universe" is used by us in our day.
 - c. Panta means the totality of creation
- 4. Three phrases indicate the relationship of his person and his acts for stating his supremacy:
 - a. "**in him**" or "**by him**" (1:16a) refers to "in his mind" or "in his sphere of influence and responsibility."
 - i. In what was eternally him and his.
 - ii. Jesus conceived of creation and all that it is and would be.
 - iii. Jesus was the architect and engineer of creation.
 - b. "**through him**" or "**by him**" (1:16b) means he produced his idea with his power and his ability.
 - i. John 1:1 "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God."
 - ii. Hebrews 1:1-4 "Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world. He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact

imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high, having become as much superior to angels as the name he has inherited is more excellent than theirs."

- c. "for him" (1:16b) the goal of all of creation was for his purpose and plan.
- 5. "Heaven" here is the unseen, spiritual heavenlies of Eph.1:3,20; 2;6; 3:10, non-material world without space, time, matter.
- 6. "Earth" is the temporal world or the "Heavens and Earth" (universe) of Creation with time, space, matter
- 7. Spiritual beings and classes of angelic beings.
 - a. These have dominant place in this epistle
 - b. Discussed in 2:8-3:4
 - i. "Thrones" meaning "throne", "a king's throne", "seat of power"
 - ii. "<u>Powers</u>" "<u>Dominion</u>" *kyriotetos* "lordship", "domination", "dignity".
 1. It refers to lordship and is used only 4x in the NT to identify divine or
 - angelic lordship, domination, dignity.
 - 2. Most often it is used with reference to a celestial hierarchy:
 - a. Ep. 1:21
 - b. 2 Peter 2:10 "and to keep the unrighteous under punishment until the day of judgment, and especially those who indulge in the lust of defiling passion and despise authority."
 - c. Jude 1:8 "Yet in like manner these people also, relying on their dreams, defile the flesh, reject authority, and blaspheme the glorious ones."
 - iii. "<u>Rulers</u>" archas from arche defined as "beginning, origin" and used to refer to "rule in the kingly or magisterial sense" and quasi-personal ("quasi" meaning "seemingly" or "apparently but not really") sense as "rulers" and "magistrates" and then simply as "beginning".
 - iv. "Authorities" exousias power, authority, weight.
 - 1. It refers to power and authority especially moral authority and influence.
 - 2. In later Judaism it developed into use as a spiritual power and soon was used to refer to a temporal, governmental power.
 - 3. This word *exousia* is built with the following:
 - a. the preposition *ek* (meaning "out from") intensifying the word *eimi*.
 - b. *eimi* which means "to be" or "being as a right/privilege" making the full word mean "conferred power", "given authority", "delegated empowerment" and "operating in a designated jurisdiction."
 - Matthew 7:29 says Jesus spoke as one having authority;
 Matthew 8:9 the Centurion said he was a man under authority.
 - d. It is used 102 times in the NT and translated as authorities (7x) authority (65) charge, control, domain, dominion, jurisdiction, liberty, power, right.



Underworld Verses:

- 1. Sheol an intermediate state where souls are dealt with according to their lives on earth.
 - a. 65x in the OT and is translated as:
 - i. "grave"
 - ii. "hell"
 - iii. "sheol"
 - b. Used in:
 - i. 35x in the Writings which are 24 Hebrew books in the Old Testament. The Writings consists of Psalms, Proverbs, Job, the Song of Songs, Ruth, Lamentations, Ecclesiastes, Esther, Daniel, Ezra-Nehemiah (one book), First and Second Chronicles (one book)—24 books in total.
 - ii. 7x in the **Law** which are Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy 5 books.
 - iii. 19x in the **Prophets** which are:
 - 1. <u>Former Prophets</u> =
 - a. Joshua,
 - b. Judges,
 - c. 1 and 2 Samuel (one book),
 - d. 1 and 2 Kings (one book)

 - c. Described in Scripture:
 - i. Psalm 89:48 "What man can live and never see death? Who can deliver his soul from the power of Sheol?"
 - ii. Job 7:9-10 "As the cloud fades and vanishes, so he who goes down to Sheol does not come up; he returns no more to his house, nor does his place know him anymore."
 - iii. Genesis 37:35 "All his sons and all his daughters rose up to comfort him, but he refused to be comforted and said, "No, I shall go down to Sheol to my son, mourning." Thus his father wept for him."

- iv. Psalm 9:17 "The wicked shall return to Sheol, all the nations that forget God."
- v. Psalm 49:15 "But God will ransom my soul from the power of Sheol, for he will receive me."

- d. Translated into Greek in the LXX (Septuagint) as "hades" 61x
- 2. Hades
 - a. Matthew 11:23 "And you, Capernaum, will you be exalted to heaven? You will be brought down to Hades. For if the mighty works done in you had been done in Sodom, it would have remained until this day."
 - b. Matthew 16:18 "And I tell you, you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of hell ["hades"] shall not prevail against it."
 - c. Acts 2:27-31 "For you will not abandon my soul to Hades, or let your Holy One see corruption."
 - d. (Never found in Epistles)
 - e. Revelation uses Hades 3x and always followed by "death" meaning "hades" and "death" are not the same thing in Revelation
 - i. Revelation 20:13-15 "And the sea gave up the dead who were in it, Death and

<u>Hades</u> (*Thanatos* $\theta \dot{\alpha} \nu \alpha \tau \sigma \zeta$ and *hades* $\ddot{\alpha} \delta \eta \zeta$) gave up the dead who were in them, and they were judged, each one of them, according to what they had done. Then <u>Death and Hades</u> were thrown into the <u>lake of fire</u> (*limne tou pyros* from

 $\lambda i \mu \nu \eta \tau o \tilde{\upsilon} \pi \upsilon \varrho \delta \varsigma$). This is the second death, the <u>lake of fire</u>. And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire."

 - b. Greek word paradeisos is used 27x in the LXX (Greek translation of the OT) to translate

the Hebrew *pardes* and the Hebrew word for "garden"] / /gan/

- i. To refer to the Garden of Eden"
 - 1. Genesis 2:8,9,10 -

"And the Lord God planted a <u>garden</u> in Eden, in the east, and there he put the man whom he had formed. And out of the ground the Lord God made to spring up every tree that is pleasant to the sight and good for food. The **tree of life** was in the midst of the <u>garden</u>, and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. A river flowed out of Eden to water the <u>garden</u>, and there it divided and became four rivers. The name of the first is the Pishon. It is the one that flowed around the whole land of Havilah, where there is gold."

- c. *Paradeisos* is used 3x in the New Testament:
 - i. Luke 23:43 "And he said to him, "Truly, I say to you, today you will be with me in <u>paradise</u>."
 - ii. 2 Corinthians 12:3-4 "And I know that this man was caught up into <u>paradise</u> whether in the body or out of the body I do not know, God knows— and he heard things that cannot be told, which man may not utter."
 - iii. Revelation 2:7 "To the one who conquers I will grant to eat of **the tree of life**, which is in the <u>paradise</u> of God."
 - iv. Ezekiel 31:15-17 ""Thus says the Lord God: On the day the cedar went down to <u>Sheol</u> I caused mourning; I closed the deep over it, and restrained its rivers, and many waters were stopped. I clothed Lebanon in gloom for it, and all the trees of the field fainted because of it. I made the nations quake at the sound of its fall, when I cast it down to Sheol with those who go down to the pit. And <u>all the trees</u> <u>of Eden</u>, the choice and best of Lebanon, all that drink water, were comforted in the world below. They also went down to Sheol with it, to those who are slain by the sword; yes, those who were its arm, who lived under its shadow among the nations.

 - a. 2 Peter 2:4 "For if God did not spare angels when they sinned, but cast them into <u>hell (*Tartarus*</u>) and committed them to chains of gloomy darkness to be kept until the judgment."

- b. Jude 6 "the angels who did not stay within their own position of authority, but left their proper dwelling, he has kept in eternal chains under gloomy darkness until the judgment of the great day
- 8. Gehenna
 - a. from Hebrew *ge Hinnom*, or "Valley of Hinnom" or "Valley of the Sons of Hinnom" south or Jerusalem.
 - b. It became a burning garbage pit.
 - c. Used 11x in Matthew, Mark and Luke
 - d. Used 1x in James 3:6 "And the tongue is a fire, a world of unrighteousness. The tongue is set among our members, staining the whole body, setting on fire the entire course of life, and set on fire by <u>hell</u>."
- 9. Lake of Fire *limne tou pyros* from $\lambda i \mu \nu \eta \tau o \tilde{v} \pi v \varrho \delta \varsigma$
- 10. Hell refers to a place of future punishment for the wicked dead and translates words such as:
 - a. Lake of Fire
 - b. Gehenna
 - c. Sheol
 - d. Hades
 - e. Tartarus

"For it was not to angels that God subjected the world to come, of which we are speaking. It has been testified somewhere:

'What is man, that you are mindful of him, or the son of man, that you care for him? You made him for <u>a little while lower than **the angels**</u>; you have crowned him with glory and honor, putting everything in subjection under his feet.' "

2. First Peter 3:22 -

"the resurrection of Jesus Christ, who has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God, with angels, authorities, and powers having been subjected to him."

Then he cried to me, "Behold, those who go toward the north country have set my Spirit at rest in the north country."

Daniel 8:13-27 -

Then I heard a <u>holy one</u> speaking, and <u>another holy one</u> said to the one who spoke, "For how long is the vision concerning the regular burnt offering, the transgression that makes desolate, and the giving over of the sanctuary and host to be trampled underfoot?" 14 And he said to me, "For 2,300 evenings and mornings. Then the sanctuary shall be restored to its rightful state."

15 When I, Daniel, had seen the vision, I sought to understand it. And behold, there stood before me <u>one having the appearance of a man</u>. 16 And I heard <u>a man's voice</u> between the banks of the Ulai, and it called, "<u>Gabriel</u>, make this man understand the vision." 17 So he came near where I stood. And when he came, I was frightened and fell on my face. But he said to me, "Understand, O son of man, that the vision is for the time of the end."

18 And when he had spoken to me, I fell into a deep sleep with my face to the ground. But he touched me and made me stand up. 19 He said, "Behold, I will make known to you what shall be at the latter end of the indignation, for it refers to the appointed time of the end. 20 As for the ram that you saw

with the two horns, these are the kings of Media and Persia. 21 And the goat is the king of Greece. And the great horn between his eyes is the first king. 22 As for the horn that was broken, in place of which four others arose, four kingdoms shall arise from his[e] nation, but not with his power. 23 And at the latter end of their kingdom, when the transgressors have reached their limit, a king of bold face, one who understands riddles, shall arise. 24 His power shall be great—but not by his own power; and he shall cause fearful destruction and shall succeed in what he does, and destroy mighty men and the people who are the saints. 25 By his cunning he shall make deceit prosper under his hand, and in his own mind he shall become great. Without warning he shall destroy many. And he shall even rise up against the Prince of princes, and he shall be broken—but by no human hand. 26 The vision of the evenings and the mornings that has been told is true, but seal up the vision, for it refers to many days from now."

27 And I, Daniel, was overcome and lay sick for some days. Then I rose and went about the king's business, but I was appalled by the vision and did not understand it."

Daniel 10:4-21 -

On the twenty-fourth day of the first month, as I was standing on the bank of the great river (that is, the Tigris) 5 I lifted up my eyes and looked, and behold, a man clothed in linen, with a belt of fine gold from Uphaz around his waist. 6 His body was like beryl, his face like the appearance of lightning, his eyes like flaming torches, his arms and legs like the gleam of burnished bronze, and the sound of his words like the sound of a multitude. 7 And I, Daniel, alone saw the vision, for the men who were with me did not see the vision, but a great trembling fell upon them, and they fled to hide themselves. 8 So I was left alone and saw this great vision, and no strength was left in me. My radiant appearance was fearfully changed,[b] and I retained no strength. 9 Then I heard the sound of his words, and as I heard the sound of his words, I fell on my face in deep sleep with my face to the ground.

10 And behold, a hand touched me and set me trembling on my hands and knees. 11 And he said to me, "O Daniel, man greatly loved, understand the words that I speak to you, and stand upright, for now I have been sent to you." And when he had spoken this word to me, I stood up trembling. 12 Then he said to me, "Fear not, Daniel, for from the first day that you set your heart to understand and humbled yourself before your God, your words have been heard, and I have come because of your words. 13 The prince of the kingdom of Persia withstood me twenty-one days, but Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me, for I was left there with the kings of Persia, 14 and came to make you understand what is to happen to your people in the latter days. For the vision is for days yet to come."

15 When he had spoken to me according to these words, I turned my face toward the ground and was mute. 16 And behold, one in the likeness of the children of man touched my lips. Then I opened my mouth and spoke. I said to him who stood before me, "O my lord, by reason of the vision pains have come upon me, and I retain no strength. 17 How can my lord's servant talk with my lord? For now no strength remains in me, and no breath is left in me."

18 Again one having the appearance of a man touched me and strengthened me. 19 And he said, "O man greatly loved, fear not, peace be with you; be strong and of good courage." And as he spoke to me, I was strengthened and said, "Let my lord speak, for you have strengthened me." 20 Then he said, "Do you know why I have come to you? But now I will return to fight against the prince of Persia;

and when I go out, behold, the prince of Greece will come. 21 But I will tell you what is inscribed in the book of truth: there is none who contends by my side against these except Michael, your prince.

Revelation 4:6-11 -

And around the throne, on each side of the throne, are four living creatures, full of eyes in front and behind: 7 the first living creature like a lion, the second living creature like an ox, the third living creature with the face of a man, and the fourth living creature like an eagle in flight. 8 And the four living creatures, each of them with six wings, are full of eyes all around and within, and day and night they never cease to say,

"Holy, holy, holy, is the Lord God Almighty, who was and is and is to come!"

9 And whenever the living creatures give glory and honor and thanks to him who is seated on the throne, who lives forever and ever, 10 the twenty-four elders fall down before him who is seated on the throne and worship him who lives forever and ever. They cast their crowns before the throne, saying,

11 "Worthy are you, our Lord and God,

to receive glory and honor and power,

for you created all things,

and by your will they existed and were created."
