

- **Where did the demons go after the pigs drown?** (Mark 5:13; Matthew 8:32)
 - “When the unclean spirit has gone out of a person, it passes through waterless places seeking rest, and finding none it says, ‘I will return to my house from which I came.’ On its return, it finds the house swept clean and put in order. Then it goes and brings seven other spirits more evil than itself, and they enter and dwell there. And the last state of that person is worse than the first.” – Luke 11:24-26 (Matthew 12:43)

- Genesis 6:1-9
 - Matthew 22:30 – “For in the resurrection they neither marry, nor are given in marriage, but are as the angels of God in heaven.”
 - Book of Enoch (written around 300 BC; quoted in Jude 14) understood the Nephilim
 - “Nephilim” means “fallen ones”
 - “Rephaim” means “the dead ones”
 - Nephilim are great warriors and giants as in Ezekiel 32:27 and Numbers 13:33
 - Dt. 1:28; 2:10-11, 3:11 – the Anakites
 - 2 Samuel 5:18 – Rephi, or the Valley of Rephaim
 - 2 Sam. 21:15-22 – giants, descendants Rapha as in Dt. 2:10, 20; Anakites in Jos. 11:21
 - Joshua 11:21-22 – Giants driven into Gaza, Philistia

- Jesus victorious ascension
 - Luke 24:50-53
 - Acts 1:9-11
 - Colossians 2:15 – “He disarmed the rulers and authorities and put them to open shame, by triumphing over them in him.” (Colossians 2:10, Ephesians 6:12)
 - 1 Timothy 3:16 – “was seen by angels”

- Heavenly Powers judged and cast down in the end times when Jesus returns
 - Isaiah 24:21 – “On that day the LORD will punish the host of heaven, in heaven, and the kings of the earth, on the earth.”
 - Isaiah 27:1- “In that day the LORD with his hard and great and strong sword will punish Leviathan the fleeing serpent, Leviathan (Hb: “*twisted*”) the twisting serpent, and he will slay the dragon that is in the sea.”
 - Psalm 74:14 –
