"in him we were also <u>chosen</u>, having been <u>predestined</u> according to the <u>plan</u> of him who works out everything in conformity with the <u>purpose</u> of his <u>will</u>,

ἐκληοώθημεν - "we were also chosen" is translated "we were claimed", "we have been given our share in the heritage" (NEB), we have been destined and appointed" (RSV). This verb which means "<u>assign</u>" or "obtain an inheritance" is in the passive which means God did the assigning. In **Deut. 32:8-9** the nations were assigned to angels while YHWH assigned himself Israel. This is the assigning of us in Christ to God.

<u>προορισθέντες</u> means "<u>determine before</u>, ordain, predestinate"

πρόθεσιν means "purpose"

<u>βουλὴν</u> means "advise, <u>counsel</u>"

<u>θελήματος</u> means "<u>desire</u>, pleasure, will"

"in order that we, who were the first to hope in Christ, might be for the praise of his glory.

"we" could be the Jewish believers

"And you also were included in Christ when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation. Having believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit,

"you" could then be the Gentile believers. That makes this a letter to the Gentiles concerning the salvation that has come to them through the Jewish Messiah.

Consider: Peter at Cornelius' house (Acts 11:15), the Jerusalem church, and then the Antioch church.

2 Corinthians 1:22 – the anointing, the seal and the guarantee

Acts 19:2 – Paul asks the disciples at Ephesus

Romans 8:9 – the promise or promised Holy Spirit indicates that his coming was promised but that his coming is a promise of future glory.

Ephesians 4:30 – sealed for the day of redemption

This is all in line with verses 1:9-10
